

SEGIR Macro II Facts

- **Broad Based Scope**—covers a wide variety of technical needs, from macroeconomic policy, tax and budget policy and management, public finance, poverty analysis, money and banking, and central banking to regulatory policy, trade and exchange rate policy, economics training, institutional reform and strengthening, sectoral analysis and policy, and environmental economics.
- **Significant Resources**—seven awardees share an IQC ceiling of \$2.4 billion.
- **Streamlined Process**—task orders may be awarded via a 2-page cost / 10-page technical proposal.
- **Duration**—IQC runs through September 2009. Tasks orders may run through September 2010.
- **Simplified Costing**—modified time-and-material provisions with established:
 - Fixed daily rates for US expatriates.
 - Fixed multiplier for TCNs and CCNs.
 - Fixed labor categories.

Task Order Issuance

USAID Contracting Officers can use SEGIR Macro II to issue task orders quickly and easily in response to rapid changes in increasingly complex programmatic needs.

After submitting statements of work to the SEGIR Macro II CTO for clearance, the task order CO is responsible for final selection, negotiation, and award.

COs can take advantage of the IQC's simplified task order RFP procedures for task orders of any size, thus greatly streamlining the evaluation process.
